Germinate Groups: affordable learning communities for rural multi-church groups germinate.net/training/germinate-groups

An ecumenical resource that enables lay and ordained leaders from multi-church groups to spend time together and learn from other groups, considering what IS (what God is doing in their area), what COULD BE (the God-given vision for our area) and what WILL BE (our six-month action plan to move towards this vision). Four two day sessions over two years covering the themes of journey, leadership, discipleship and mission and can be led by church groups themselves with ARC support and facilitator training, keeping costs low.

Germinate Enterprise: a rural business start-up programme germinate.net/mission/germinate-enterprise

This six session programme is designed to be delivered by churches to help provide jobs, retain working age people in villages and tackle hidden poverty.
