Following the feedback at the February meeting, the shape of the document has been substantially revised and updated in the light of coronavirus. It now comprises an initial paper "A Theological Celebration of Rural Life, Ministry and Mission" followed by a five session toolkit. The full resource is called "Lightening the Load: Freeing the church for mission" and subtitled "A resource for multi-parish rural benefices in the wake of coronavirus". The project has been handed over to Sarah Cracknell and the Growing the Rural Church Team to enable it to be taken forward and integrated with other work streams.
